





Magic X and IRR

- Money-back (X) the main benchmark of VC industry
 - IRR is secondary
- Link between X and IRR

- Individual expected IRRs of portfolio investments shall be 2X bigger to compensate for
 - failures
 - Fund manager's costs
 - Time and money lost on entry and exit
- VCs expect the investee companies to deliver minimum 35-50% IRR over 5 years

[Estonia] "Don't talk, just execute". That was the goal of Garage48, a sort of bootcamp-meetshackathon organised by the Estonian Startup Leaders Club, a non-profit organization that works with major startup founders from Estonia.







