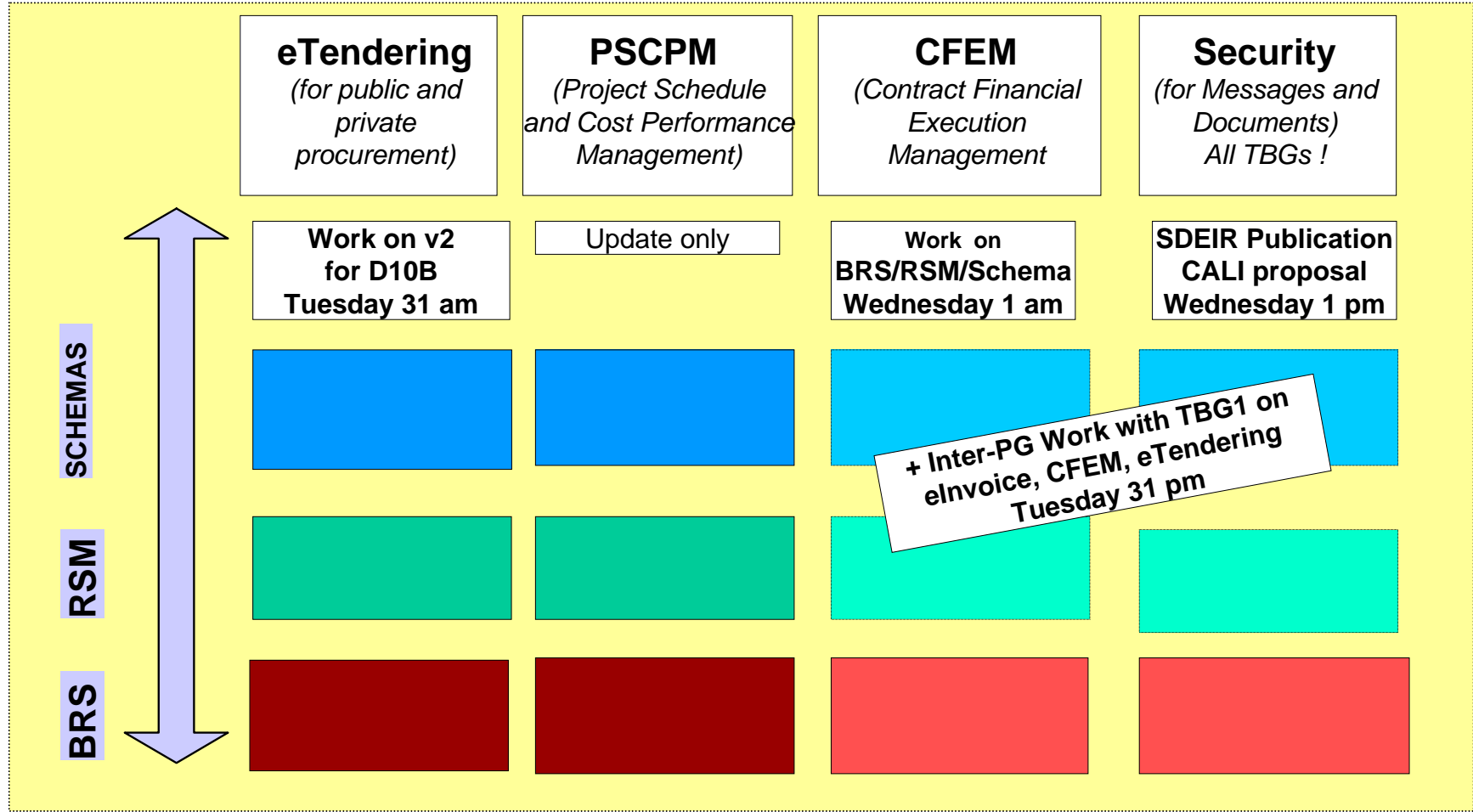

- The goal of the day was:
 - Discuss global trends, their implications to the insurance industry, and their relevance to process-, message- and data-standards
 - Embrace the future confidently and think beyond day-to-day activities
- Presentations, panel discussion, breakout-sessions and interactive session with the whole audience
- 31 participants – TBG8 plus 25 “outside guests” from the insurance industry
 - Insurers, reinsurers, service providers, consultants



Outcome of the Discussions:

- Which trends are impacting the industry most from risk perspective
 - Global warming/climate change
 - Growth (people, insured risks)
 - Demographics (ageing versus young society)
 - Muslim compliant insurance



- Which trends are impacting the insurance industry from the service/operational perspective
 - “Customerization” – the customer in the center
 - transparency on the customer needs
 - responsiveness to his/her individual needs
 - products for the ageing society
 - 24/7 real-time response
 - Dis/re/intermediation, impact on changing role for broker/intermediary
 - Technology (nanotechnology, mobile computing, technology conversion)
 - Speed – need, go for it



- Challenges related to standards:
 - Continuous change
 - Stay simple for the user community, hiding complexity
 - Replacement of legacy
 - Where are the incentives? Management support for standards usage – where is competitive edge? Funding? Implementation effort
 - Finding consensus, ambiguity, interpretation of standards



- Opportunities related to standards:
 - Cost reductions, incl. application development costs, business interaction/inter-operability
 - Improved data quality, market statistic, more accurate information for decision making
 - Transparency on business activities, practices
 - New information services, distribution channels, market access; reshaping the business instead of just running it



- Recommendations for standard bodies going forward...
four categories
 - **Mindset perspective:**
 - Thought-leadership, leading role, standards leading the way as enabling factor
 - **Business advantage**
 - Accelerate time to adopt standards -> global players
 - Make good reference case, business case linking to opportunities
 - Get clear view on advantages for early adopters versus followers



- Recommendations for standard bodies going forward...
four categories
 - **Internal, service offerings**
 - Standardize the standards as a shared language; validation/certification
 - Standards will also be subject of change – build in agility, flexibility...raising the bar
 - Faster delivery of standards, quick maintenance cycles; tougher on time/projects
 - Optimize internal processes, procedures, communication
 - **Communication/Marketing/Conference**
 - Strengthened cooperation between standards organization, enlarge the community, marketing for Europe
