





### **Energy Efficiency 21 Programme**

- Launched in 1991 6 three-year phases until 2009
- Enhance East-West Trade and Cooperation
- Environment UNECE Conventions
- UNFCCC Kyoto Protocol
- Improve Capacities and Networking
- Energy Efficiency Policy Reforms
- Financing Energy Efficiency Investments





#### **Seventh 3-year phase of the Project**

Approved by the 20th Session of the Steering Committee in June 2009

Endorsed by the Committee on Sustainable Energy in November 2009

Renamed: Energy Efficiency (EE21) Programme

### **General Objective**

To enhance regional cooperation on energy efficiency market formation and investment project development to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in economies in transition



### **Immediate Objectives**

- Objective 1: Accelerate regional networking between national participating institutions and international partners by enhanced Internet communications.
- Objective 2: Promote municipal level projects to enable local and concrete Energy Efficiency development.
- Objective 3: Develop and harmonize regional policies and standards to introduce the economic, institutional and regulatory reforms needed.


