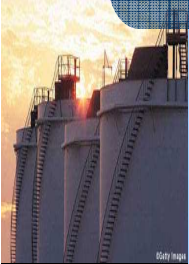

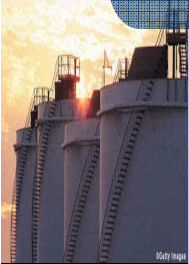
# GEE21 Project: General Objective



- **Systematic exchange of experience through UN Regional Commissions**
  - ☞ capacity building
  - ☞ policy reforms
  - ☞ investment project finance
- **Promote self-financing energy efficiency improvements**
  - ☞ raise economic productivity
  - ☞ diminish fuel poverty
  - ☞ reduce air pollution and greenhouse gas emissions



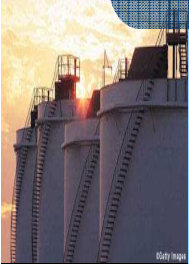
# GEE21 Project: Immediate Objectives



- **Objective 1: Disseminate experience of FEEI to other ECE member countries and countries of the other regions;**
- **Objective 2: Increase capacity of Regional Commissions to provide effective energy efficiency services;**
- **Objective 3: Improve global capacity to promote self-financing energy efficiency improvements for climate change mitigation.**



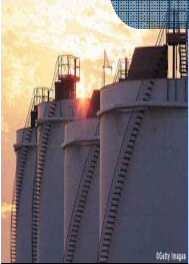
# Group of Experts on GEEI 21 Project



- **First session of the Group of Experts (June 2010):**
  - Elected Bureau
  - Presented the publication “*Financing Global Climate Change Mitigation*”
  - Introduced the draft work programme for 2010-2011
  - Requested the secretariat to compile an inventory of existing or planned projects within the Regional Commissions
- **Extended Bureau meeting (October 2011)**
  - Agreed to pool each region’s expertise and nominate a Task Force members.
  - The work of this Task Force is intended to lead to the formulation of the “**Global Strategy for EE Market Formation**”.
  - A draft Global Strategy will be presented to the Group of Experts during its Second meeting.



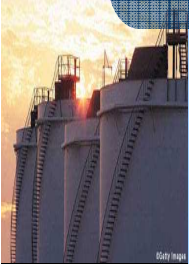
# GEEI 21 Project: status, deliverables, events



- The inventory of existing or planned projects was compiled.
- The GEE21 background paper was prepared and presented in Cancun the
- Terms of references was prepared for a Consultant to work on draft Global Strategy on Energy Efficiency Market Formation.
- The UN Development Account project proposal on regional aspects of GEE 21 was prepared and submitted for funding
- The draft “Global Strategy for Energy Efficiency Market Formation” was prepared by the selected Consultant “Econoler International”



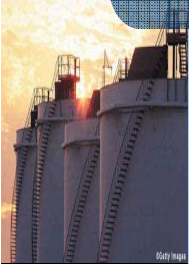
# GEEI 21 Project: status, deliverables, events

- **Development of a draft Global Strategy on Energy Efficiency Market Formation**



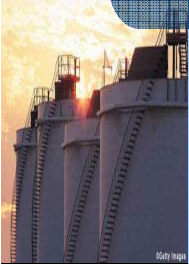
# **GEEI 21 Project: status, deliverables, events (cntd.)**

# GEEI 21 Project: budget

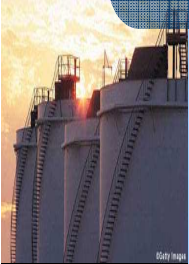


- **US\$ 150 thousand for 2008-2010 provided by the Russian Federation. Financing expected to continue going forward.**
- **A dedicated post at P-4 level provided from the UN Development Pillar.**
- **DA – 8<sup>th</sup> tranche is expected**
- **Extensive fund-raising is essential for the success of the GEE21 project.**

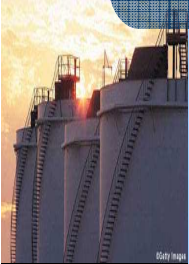




# GEEI 21 Project: Proposed Activities
