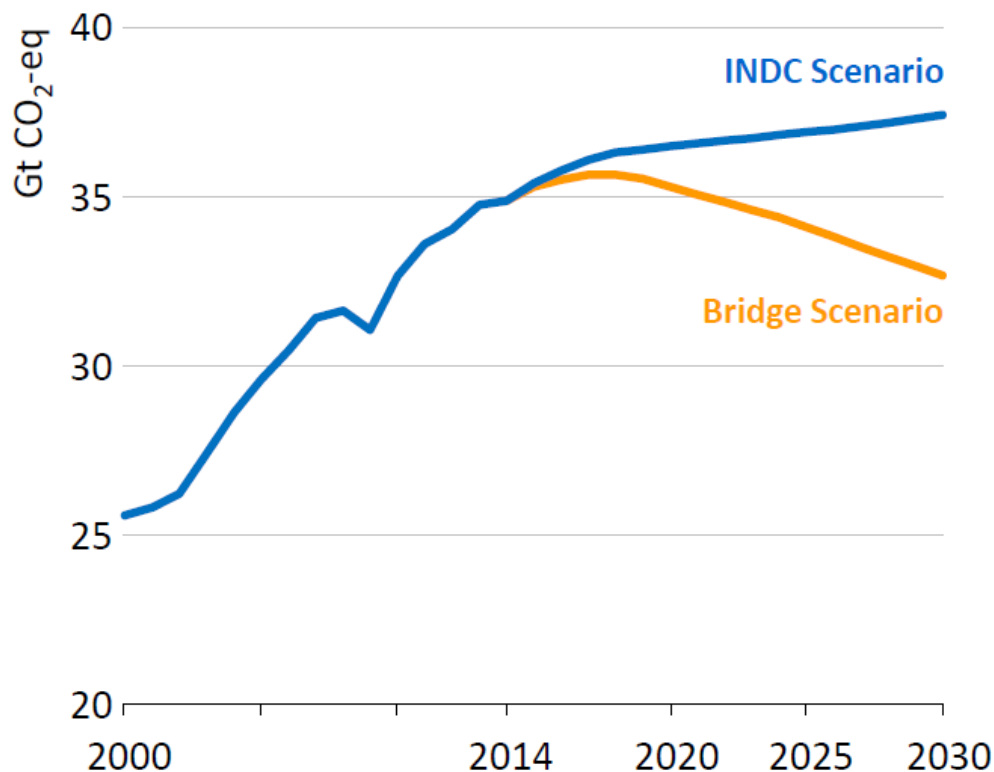

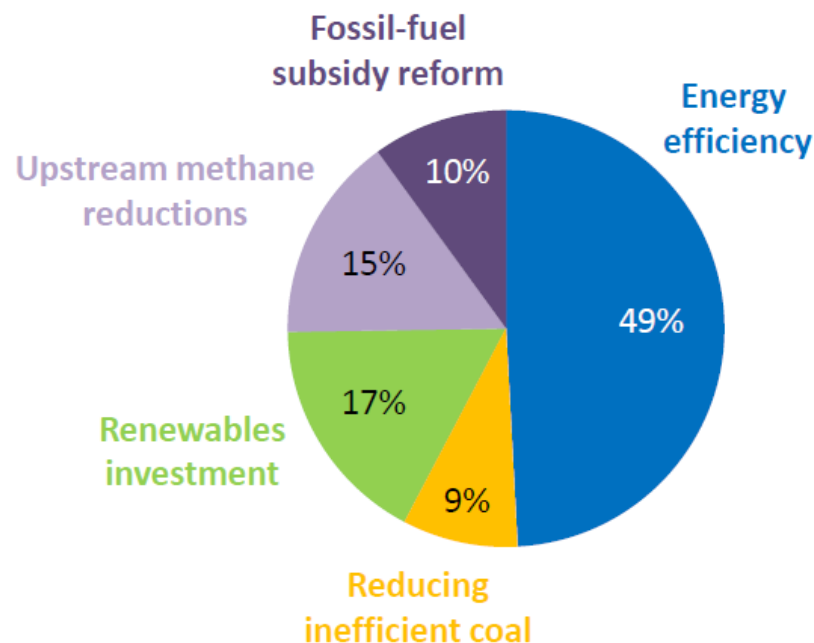

Global energy-related GHG emissions



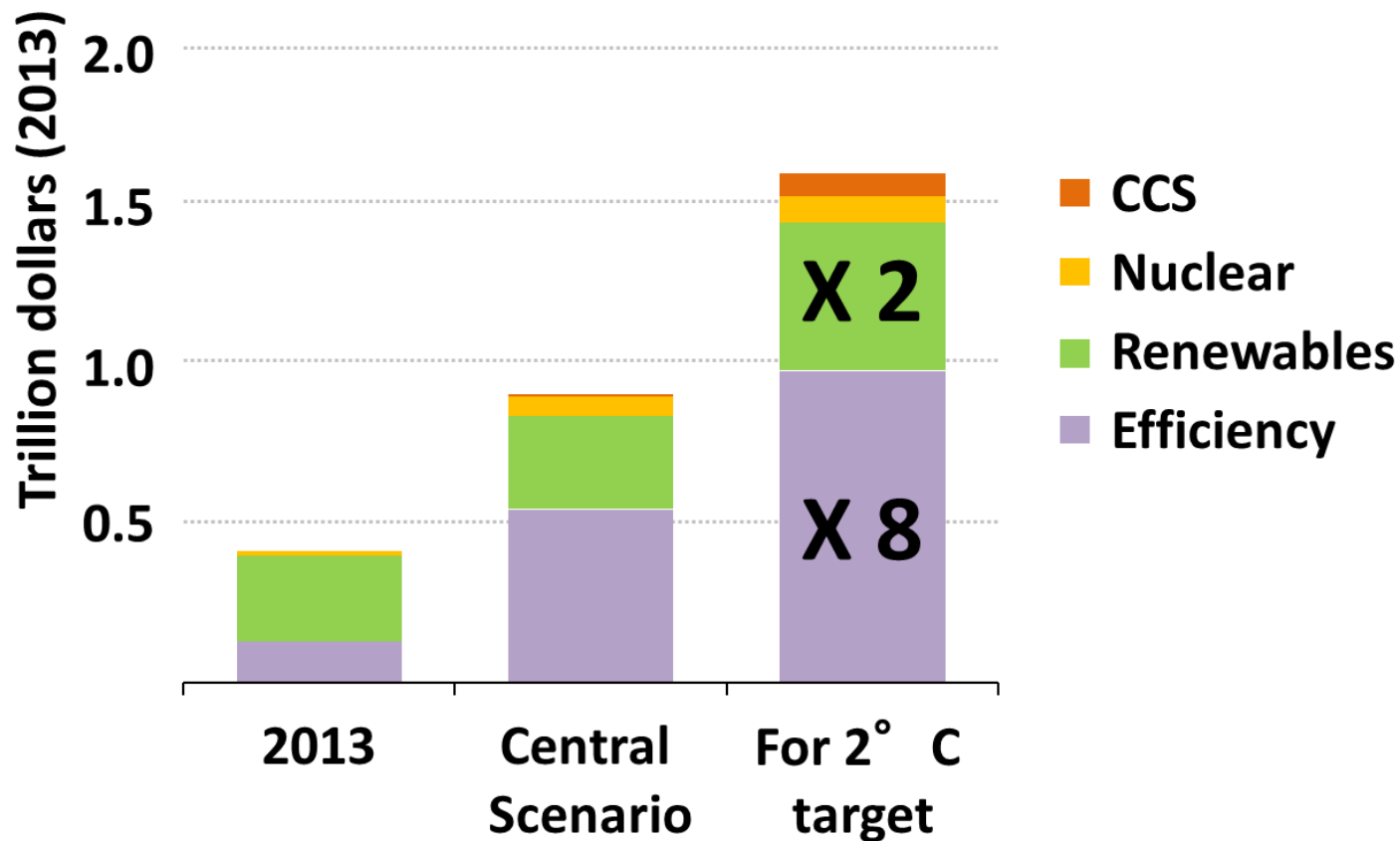
Savings by measure, 2030
