Conclusion

- Requirements for Turkey: Internationally acceptable reporting standard
 - To end problem of terminology caos
 - Reporting not only by geological knowlodge but also by economic&social viability and Feasibility &project status
 - Require both public market reporting and inventories reporting
 - Public market reporting for investors & stock exchanges
 - invontories reporting for resource management
 - Compatible energy statictics

Conclusion

- Decision taken to establish a National Team composed of all related bodies
 - Legal infrastructure of the National Team is being prepared by MIGEM
- Alignment with UNFC, cross mapping with CRIRSCO
- Nomination of Turkey to involve STF studies
