#### The main objectives:

- Legislation approximation with EU directives;
- Low enforcement;
- Institutional strengthening;
- Sustainable administration of environment, natural resources and biodiversity,

## Legislation approximation:

- Low for environmental protection; (Full approximated with eu directive)
- Low for EIA; (Full approximated with eu directive)
- Low on environmental permit; (Full approximated with eu directive)
- Low for integrated management of waste; (Full approximated with eu directive, include and hazard waste)
- Low for water reserves; (Full approximated with eu directive)
- Low for biodiversity etc. (in force);
  - Low on hunting, moratorium of hunting for tow year Strategy for environment, 2015-2020,
- Strategy for waste management (in force)
- National action plan for waste, 2010 (In force)

#### Low enforcement:

- Implementation of principle "Polluter pay";
- Transparent and public participation in EIA process;
- Cross border collaboration and exchange information
- Reorganization of national inspectorate for environment and forest; (NIEF)
- Establishment of National Agency for the Protected Area (NAPA) (organized in 12 regions)
- Reorganized of National Agency for Environment
- Reorganized of Forest servis in regional level;

## **Integrated Waste management:**

- 1. Landfill construction (according to EU standard);
- 2. Reduce the waste generation (public education,),
- 3. Reuse the waste; (improving the technology for reuse as a row material, including incentives)
- 4. Recycling of waste ( support for the business focus on recycling as : paper, metal, wood, textile and plastic recycling)
- 5. Energy production from waste (first incinerator in Albsnia)

#### **Energy sector. The priorities:**

- About 80% of the demands for the energy is sure by hidro energy;
- Energy efficiency;
- Removable resource of energy
  - a) water energy; (3 main hydro power plant and more then 50 small and medium given by concession)
    - b) wind energy; ( wind atlas, Neolithic parks in construction, )
  - c) solar energy; ( evaluation of Albanian market and incentives to promote this new technology, focus on water heating);
- CDM project and Kyoto protocol (Albania has DNA, Legal framework for CDM, 3 project validated in energy efficiency, solar energy, forest carbon sequestration)

## Water resources and priorities;

- ➤ Albania is very rich in water resources (six basin of the rivers; Shkodra, Ohrid and Prespa lakes; about 370 Km coastal zone;
- sustainable use; protection of quality of the water resources;
- Well management of basin of the rivers;
- Monitoring system, functional and permanent;
- Prevention and protection of the territory from the flooding ( Drini, Vjosa, devolli rivers etc.)

#### The main priority on Biodiversity:

- Increasing of protected area (actually 17 % of the territory objective 20 % );
- Protection of biodiversity, (Flora and Fauna,)
- Protection of landscape and natural monuments (Albania has about 370 Natural monuments,)
- Protection of natural ecosystems especially ( wetlands ecosystems as are Kune vain, Patok, Karavasta, Narta lagoons)
- Cross Border lakes and cross border collaboration (Shkodra, Ohri, Prespa lakes):
- Integrated Costal Zone Management marine biodiversity protection (Albania has actually only one marine protected area Karaburun);
- Preparation and implementation of management plan for protected area and especially for the national parks.

## Forest and policy related with this sector:

- Reforestation;
- Rehabilitation of damaged area;
- Sustainable use of forest resources;
- Ecosystems services;
- Enforcement of measure for the protection from fire.
- Decentralization of forest administration sector ( on 2016 all forest fund will be transfer to the 61 municipalities. );
- IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECT "ECOSYSTEM SERVICES) financed by GEF 4 Mil.US\$, WB 10 Mil US\$, SIDA 10 Mil.Euro);
- Enforcement of forest extension service;

### International collaboration:

Albania is party of several convention and protocols focus on :

- biodiversity,
- clime change,
- chemicals,
- hazard waste,
- ozone depletions;
- endangered species protection,
- bio safety etc.
- Biodiversity;
