Organization of work

- 16th meeting of the UNECE Working Group on Environmental Monitoring and Assessment (WGEMA) (16-17 April)

The Regional Environmental Information Network Conference (REIN) and the 16th meeting of the WGEMA will be conducted in English and Russian and the first GEO Regional Authors' meeting in English only.

Regional Environmental Information Network Conference (13-15 April)

The plenary sessions will be conducted in English and Russian and interpretation will be available in one of the breakout rooms.

Item 1: Opening of the meeting

Item 2: Organization of the meeting and election of officers

Election of officers for the REIN. The elected officers will serve as the co-chairs of the meeting and the secretariat as the rapporteur.

Item 3: Briefing on GEO-6 global and regional assessments, SEIS & UNEP Live

Item 5: Assessment scope

A presentation will be given by the secretariat on the proposed scope of the assessment (see UNEP/GEO-6/REIN 1.3 Background Paper).

Questions for clarification.

The meeting will split in to two groups to discuss Part A (State and trends) and Part B (Environmental Policies, Goals and Objectives: A Review of Policy Responses and Options).

The meeting will reconvene in plenary to present and agree on narratives and content for Part A & B.

Item 6: Emerging Issues and Outlooks

A presentation will be given by the secretariat on UNEP's Global Gender and Environment Outlook (regional perspectives) and on Emerging Issues and Outlooks – Part C (see UNEP/GEO-6/REIN 1.3 Background Paper).

Plenary discussions and breakout groups to discuss and agree on the key elements and approaches for developing the outlooks and identifying emerging issues in the region.

Item 7: Assessment process and stakeholder roles

A presentation will be given by the secretariat on the assessment process and stakeholder roles.

Plenary discussion and agreement on roles.

Item 8: UNEP Live & National Reporting Systems

A presentation will be given by the secretariat on the use of UNEP Live and National Reporting Systems for supporting assessments (see UNEP/GEO-6/REIN 1.3 Background

Paper) and how UNEP Live could be one access point to data shared within the SEIS approach.

Plenary discussion followed by 'hands-on' training in breakout groups.
