II. Suggestions for future activities of the REM Advisory Group and on how to improve its work

- More focus on real-estate valuation
- More of the solution-oriented approach in REM activities
- More focus on preparing publications with specific recommendations and guidelines
- Expand geographical focus of the REM activities to include countries of Central Asia

III. Issues deemed underrepresented in the programme of work

- Statistical comparison of data on real estate markets in UNECE countries
- Influence of the real-estate market on urban and rural spatial planning and development
- Public-private partnerships in land administration
- Relationship between mass valuation and individual valuation of real estate and their influence on real estate markets
- Real property market prices and trends in the region (residential, commercial, agricultural)
- Link between the new technologies such as land information system or computer assisted mass appraisal system and land-registration security
- Taxation systems as they influence real-estate markets
- The creation of effective mortgage instruments in countries with economies in transition

IV. Terms of reference and composition of the REM Advisory Group

- Provide advice both to CHLM and WPLA
- Membership should be representative of ECE subregions
- The number of REM members should be increased
