- **Definition:** *“A smart sustainable city is an innovative city that uses information and communication technologies (ICTs) and other means to improve quality of life, efficiency of urban operation and services, and competitiveness, while ensuring that it meets the needs of present and future generations with respect to economic, social, environmental as well as cultural aspects.”*
- **KPIs :** UNECE-ITU Smart Sustainable Cities Indicators are the first indicators to assess cities for both their smartness and sustainability. The list consists of 72 indicators, including the core indicators and some additional ones, grouped under three areas: Economy, Environment, and Society & Culture.

- ❑ ITU-UNECE Smart Sustainable Cities KPI Project: Smart Sustainable City Indicators have already reflected the content of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which were approved in September 2015 by the United Nations General Assembly.
