Key planned activities for 2016 related to housing and urban issues

- Joint contribution to UN HABITAT III PREPCOM in Prague and development of a position paper on relevance of the integration of Sendai principles in housing and land use planning;
- UNISDR contribution to international workshops on urban and land use planning, as already provided for the workshop in Chisinau, Moldova in 2015 (TBC)
- Sharing of Practical Guidelines on integration of DRR in NAPs, to support land use planning;
- Joint UNECE workshop on safety and land use planning (industrial accidents Convention, Protocol on Strategic Environmental Assessment, Committee on Housing and Land Management, 13 April 2016, Geneva, Switzerland







Contribution to Habitat III

- Co- lead to Resilience Issue paper
- Appointed as UN Advisors to Policy Unit 8;
- Engaged in Europe Regional consultation on UNHABITAT III in Prague,
 Czech Republic (March), Toluca (Mexico), and other inter-sessional process
- Conference "Reviewing the State of Safety in World Cities" towards HABITAT III, 6-8 July, Geneva
- HABITAT III PREPCOM III, Indonesia in July
- World Habitat Day, Geneva, 3 October
- HABITAT III Conference, Quito Ecuador, 17-21 October







Proposals for cooperation

Housing and land use planning:

- Contribution to development of country profiles on housing and land management by sharing knowledge and experiences on:
 - Multi-hazard risk assessment, mapping and loss accounting
 - Climate change adaptation-practical guidelines on integration of DRR in NAPs for land use planning
 - Mainstreaming DRR consideration in evaluating affordability of housing
- Promoting safe schools and safe hospitals
- Promote engagement of vulnerable people, person with disabilities

- Contributed to development of SMART Indicators
- Roll out of Local-Urban Indicators for Urban Resilience across Europe
