GGG-PL Wave 1

- ▶ GGS-PL1 – available from the harmonized GGP data-base – as of October 2013
 - ▶ Sample of almost 20 000 individuals
- ▶ Additional segments in the Polish data:
 - ▶ Questions on: reproductive health, life satisfaction, religion and women’s attitudes towards work
 - ▶ Complete labour market biographies of respondents

FAMWELL (Family Change and Subjective Well-being) –
project coordinated by Anna Matysiak (2010-2013).

Additional data collection – purposive samples:

- ▶ Women aged 35+ and childless (n=604)
 - ▶ Mothers, who gave their first births at age 35+ (n=755)
 - ▶ Purposive samples to gain insights into childlessness and late motherhood
 - ▶ Samples limited to urban areas only
 - ▶ Questionnaire based on GGS
 - ▶ Data not harmonized but we're open to cooperation if anybody's interested!
