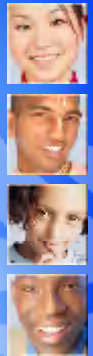

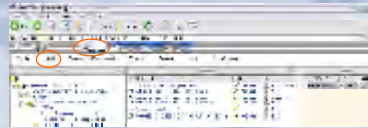


# global human development

In September 2000, 147 Heads of State, and 189 States of the United Nations in total, adopted the Millennium Declaration. The Millennium Declaration, building on the outcomes of the United Nations global conferences of the 1990s, marked a strong commitment to the right to development, to peace and security, to gender equality, to the eradication of the many dimensions of poverty and to sustainable human development. The Declaration mainstreams a set of 8 inter-connected and mutually reinforcing development goals and 18 related targets into a global agenda. There are 48 quantitative indicators for monitoring progress towards the Millennium Development Goals in **DevInfo**. This tool has been developed in cooperation with the UN system and has been adapted from UNICEF ChildInfo technology.

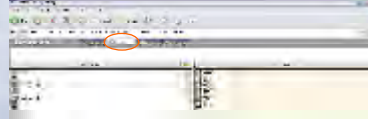

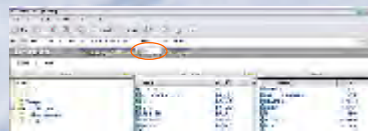
## Time Periods

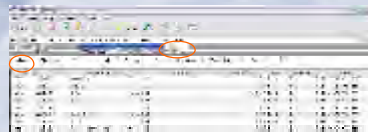

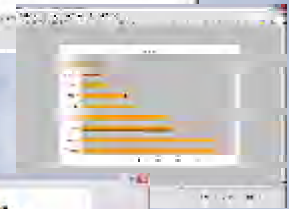
