UNECE Workshop on Measuring the Non-Observed Economy in SPECA member countries - StatCapCA Training Workshop Nr. 4

The meeting will be held at the Hotel Ak-Keme, Prospekt Mira 93, 720044 Bishkek, Kyrgyz Republic, from 25 to 27 April 2007, starting at 09.30 a.m.

The registration of participants will start at 09.00.

The Workshop is organized in cooperation with the National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic

I. PURPOSE OF THE WORKSHOP

1. The aim of the workshop is to train the experts from the national statistical offices of SPECA countries in the implementation of common methodologies to achieve a better coverage of the non-observed economy in the National Accounts. The Workshop is organized for National Accounts specialists and experts dealing with the non-observed economy in the countries of Central Asia and Azerbaijan. Participation of experts from subject-matter areas that provide the basic data for National Accounts compilation (like agriculture, industry, services, etc.) is encouraged. The participants need to be familiar with the basic concepts and methodologies in this field and be able to give short presentations on the methodologies used for measuring the non-observed economy in their respective countries.

II. PROVISIONAL AGENDA

3. Mr. Remi Bardon from Eurostat, Ms. Carol Carson, the Project Manager of the SNA93 update, Ms. Tihomira Dimova and Ms. Tiina Luige from UNECE, a representative of the UNESCAP, and country representatives will give the presentations.

III. PARTICIPATION AND ACCREDITATION

4. National Statistical Offices (NSOs) of SPECA countries are welcome to nominate two or more delegates to participate in the Workshop. UNECE will, in the framework of the UN Development Account project StatCapCA, provide financial support for the participation of <u>two delegates per country</u> (excluding the host country).

5. The statistical offices of SPECA countries are welcome to send more experts to the Workshop if their participation funded by the NSO.

IV. TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

7. All participants attending the Workshop are requested to have a valid passport and, if required, a visa. Applications for possible visas should be made as soon as possible to the Embassy of the Kyrgyz Republic in the country in which the participants reside, with a reference to the UNECE Workshop on Measuring the Non-Observed Economy in SPECA member countries. If necessary, the National Statistical Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic can provide a letter to facilitate obtaining a visa. 8. UNECE will cover airfare and per diem (Daily Subsistence Allowance - DSA) for the duration of the Workshop for two participants per country, excluding participants from the hosting country. Any other participant(s) can attend at their own costs. During the Workshop, the organizers of the Workshop will distribute to the participants the DSA at the United Nations prevailing rate in Bishkek to cover accommodation, meals and other incidental expenses. If, for any reason, the participant is unable to attend for the full duration of the Workshop, a proportionate reduction in the allowance will be made. Please note that UNECE will not assume responsibility for any other expenditures related to the travel, like visa, medical costs, etc.

- 9. In order to obtain the DSA, participants need to submit on the first day of the Workshop
 - A copy of the passport showing personal details, including photo and the immigration stamp in Bishkek;
 - A copy of the air ticket;
 - Boarding pass(es).

10. Upon receipt of confirmation of attendance and due information on financing of participation, referred to in Para 4, UNECE will make arrangements, through the local UNDP offices, to issue most direct economy air tickets for participants to travel from the country of their residence to Bishkek and return. Arrangements will be made for participants to arrive in Bishkek on Tuesday, 24 April and depart for their respective countries on Saturday, 28 April 2007, depending on available flight connections. Participants should not purchase tickets by themselves. Please note that if tickets are not issued by the rules above, the UNECE will not be in a position to reimburse them.
