

Statistics is an inherent part of UNCTAD. Being the United Nations' trust point for the integrated treatment of trade and development and the international issues in the areas of finance, technology, investment and sustainable development, UNCTAD compiles, validates and processes a wide range of data collected from national and international sources. Most of the time areas cover long periods, with some dating back to 1946, for almost all economies of the world. This allows making an analysis of emerging and most urgent issues within a framework of long-lasting tendencies and wide geographical scope.

UNCTAD's statistical work is in conformity with the Principles Governing International Statistical Activities, to which formulation and reinforcement UNCTAD has significantly contributed.


DATA CENTER
UNCTADSTAT gives access to more than 130 indicators and statistical time series. All statistics of UNCTAD are harmonized and integrated into UNCTADSTAT, free to use dissemination platform. It gives access to basic and derived indicators built upon common rules, harmonized environment and clear methodologies, supported by powerful data browsing system. A navigation browser allows table or graphic presentations, easy selection and reorganization of data, personalized functionalities and several straightforward extraction options.






