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### **Steering Group on MQoE**

- Established by CES Bureau in October 2015
- Active work since beginning of 2016
- Steering Group meeting in January 2017, Helsinki
- Participating countries: Azerbaijan, Canada, Finland, Germany, Israel, Italy, Poland, Switzerland (chair), USA
- Participating international organisations: ILO, Eurofound, Eurostat, OECD, WIEGO, UNECE



### Objectives according to Terms of Reference

- Coordinate CES work of measuring quality of employment
- Promote the Handbook, follow-up the implementation of recommendations, collect feedback from countries
- Review the list of indicators / context information based on country feedbacks, new methods and data sources
- Identify priority areas for future work




### Objectives according to Terms of Reference

- Organise biennial expert group meetings on MQoE:
  - Follow-up on research agenda
  - Implementation of statistical framework
- Facilitate the sharing of experiences, methods, statistical techniques related to MQoE
- Ensure coordination / cooperation with other international organisations working in this area (Eurostat, ILO, OECD)



## Main outputs of the Steering Group 2016-2018, according to Terms of Reference

- Implementation of the recommendations of the Handbook
- Identification of priority issues of the research agenda where more work is required
- Organisation of an expert group meeting on MQoE
