1. Strategic planning



- Key instrument to enhance political and financial support for investment in statistics
- Help to determine current strengths and weaknesses of statistical capacity
- Advocacy at national level
- Best practices of strategic planning framework readily available
- Alignment with other related international frameworks – BPM, SEEA, ISIC, CPC

2. Coordination, monitoring and reporting



- Lessons learned from 1993 SNA implementation insufficient institutional capacity and lack of international cooperation
- Defined actions of all stakeholders at national, regional and global level and ensured execution against benchmarks
- Regional Commissions to play a pivotal role implementation plans will vary by region
- Global governance ICP is a possible model for structure
