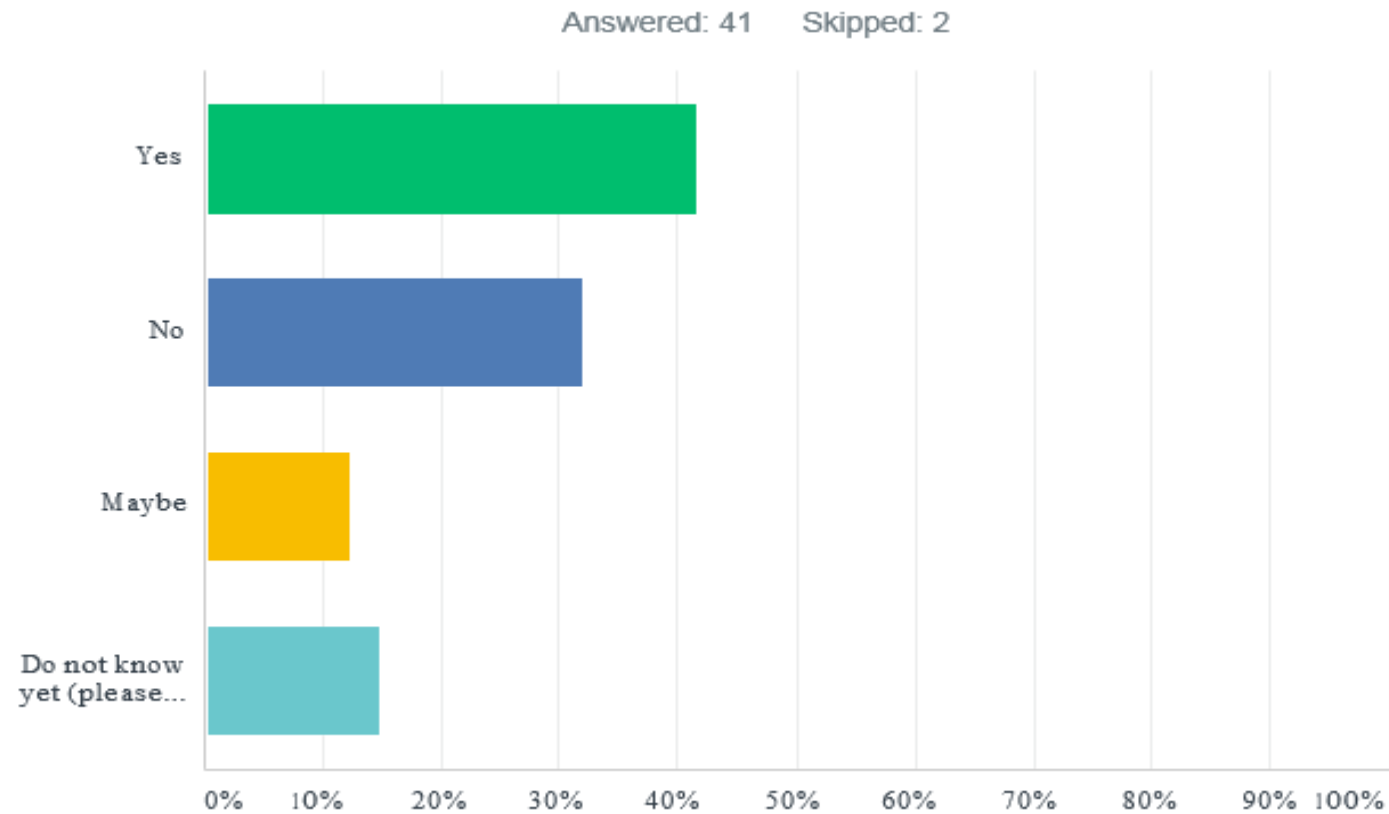

Summary

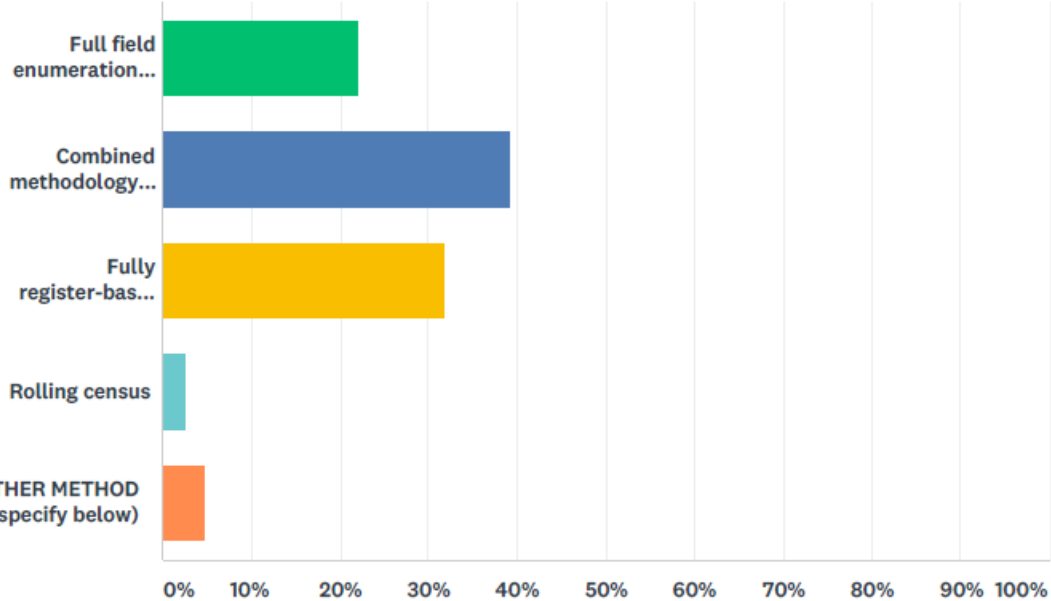
- Work conducted by the UNECE Steering Group on Population and Housing Censuses

Are you contemplating – even tentatively – changes in methodology in your next census after the 2020 round



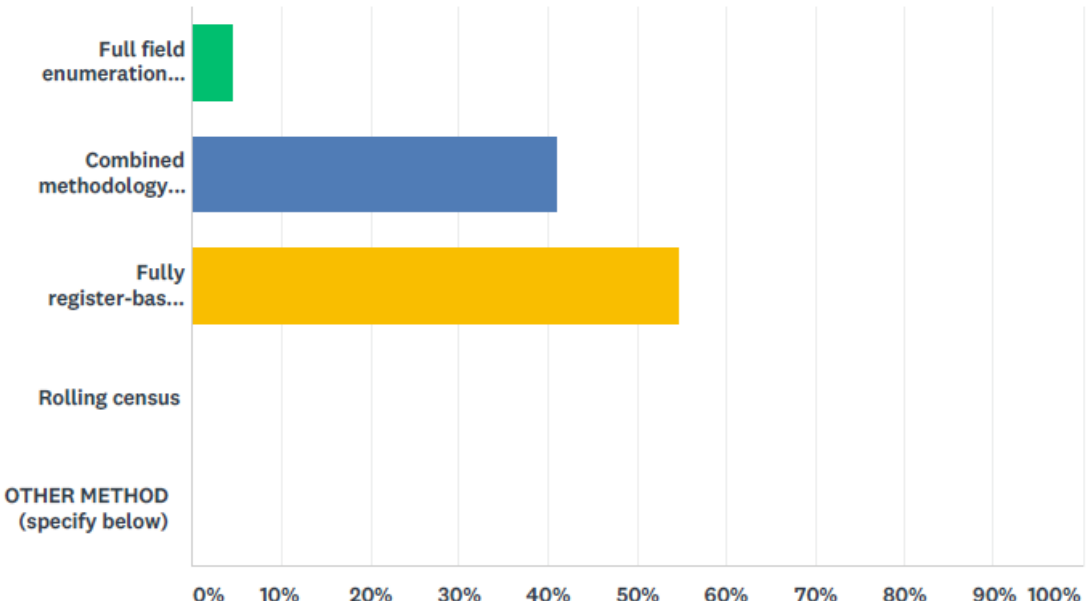
What method will be used for your census in the 2020 round?

Answered: 41 Skipped: 2



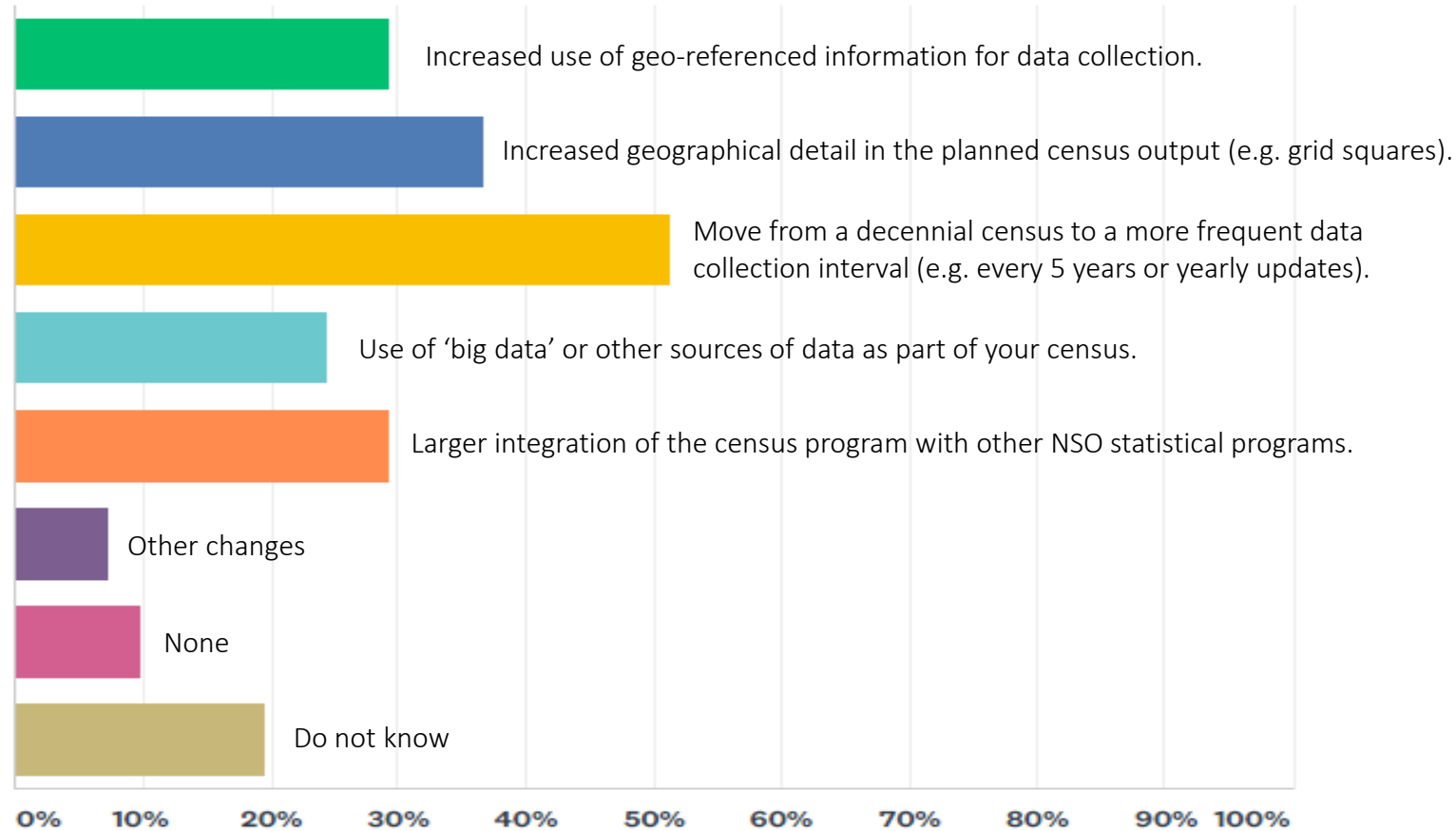
What methodology would you move to for the next census after the 2020 round?

Answered: 22 Skipped: 21

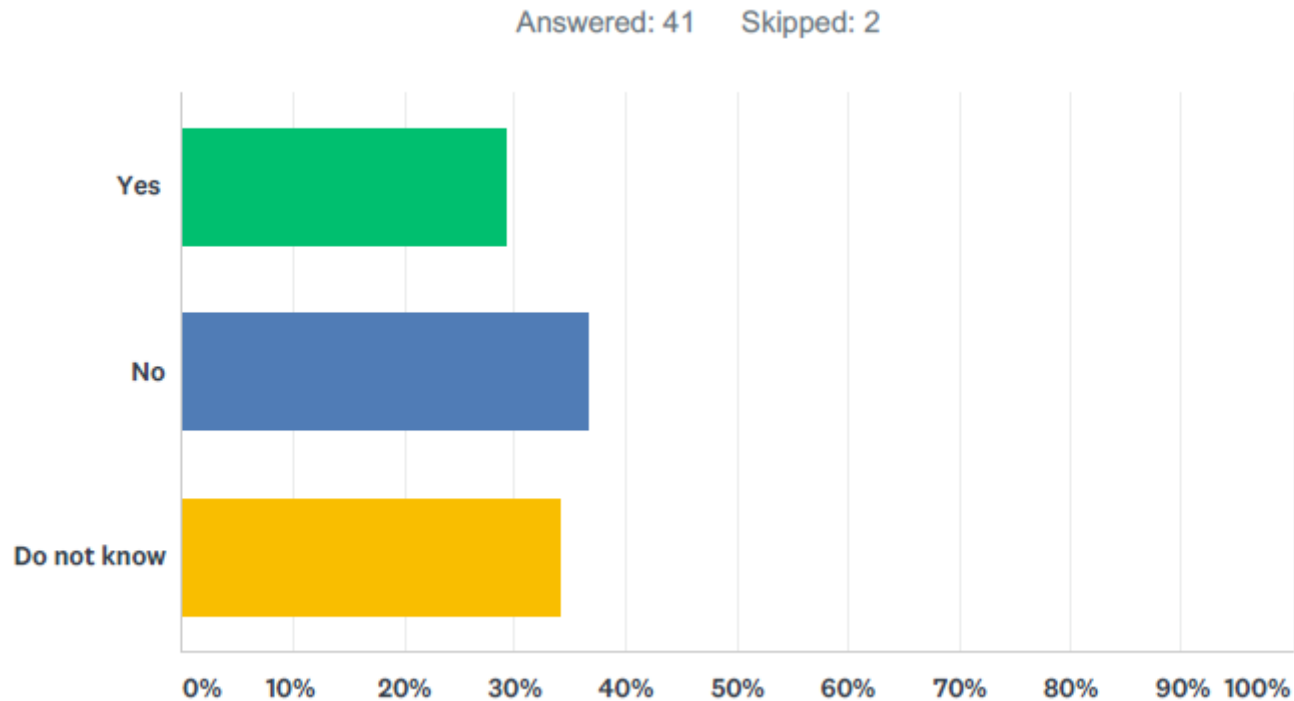


Are you contemplating other types of important changes or innovations for your next census after the 2020 round?

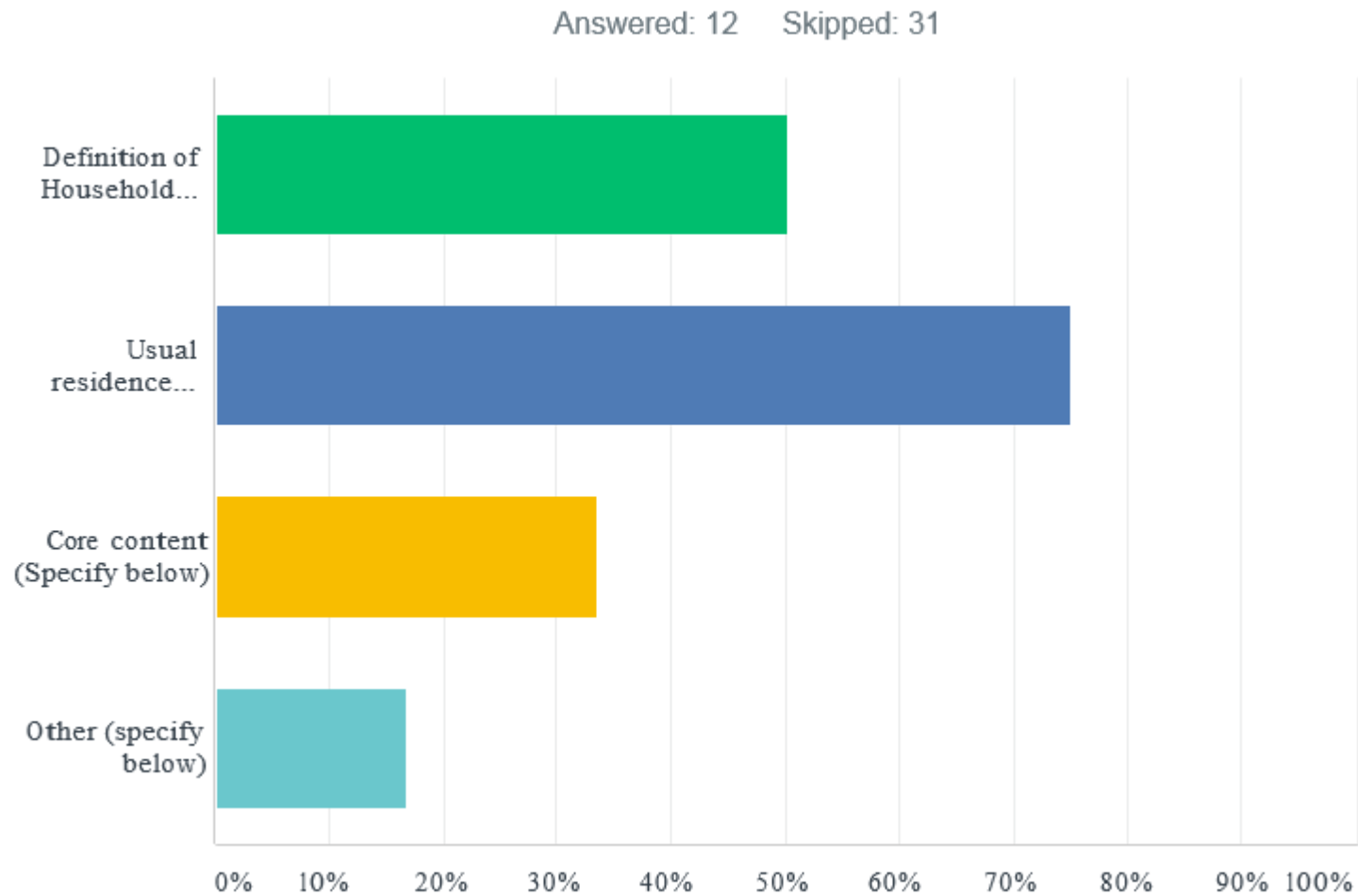

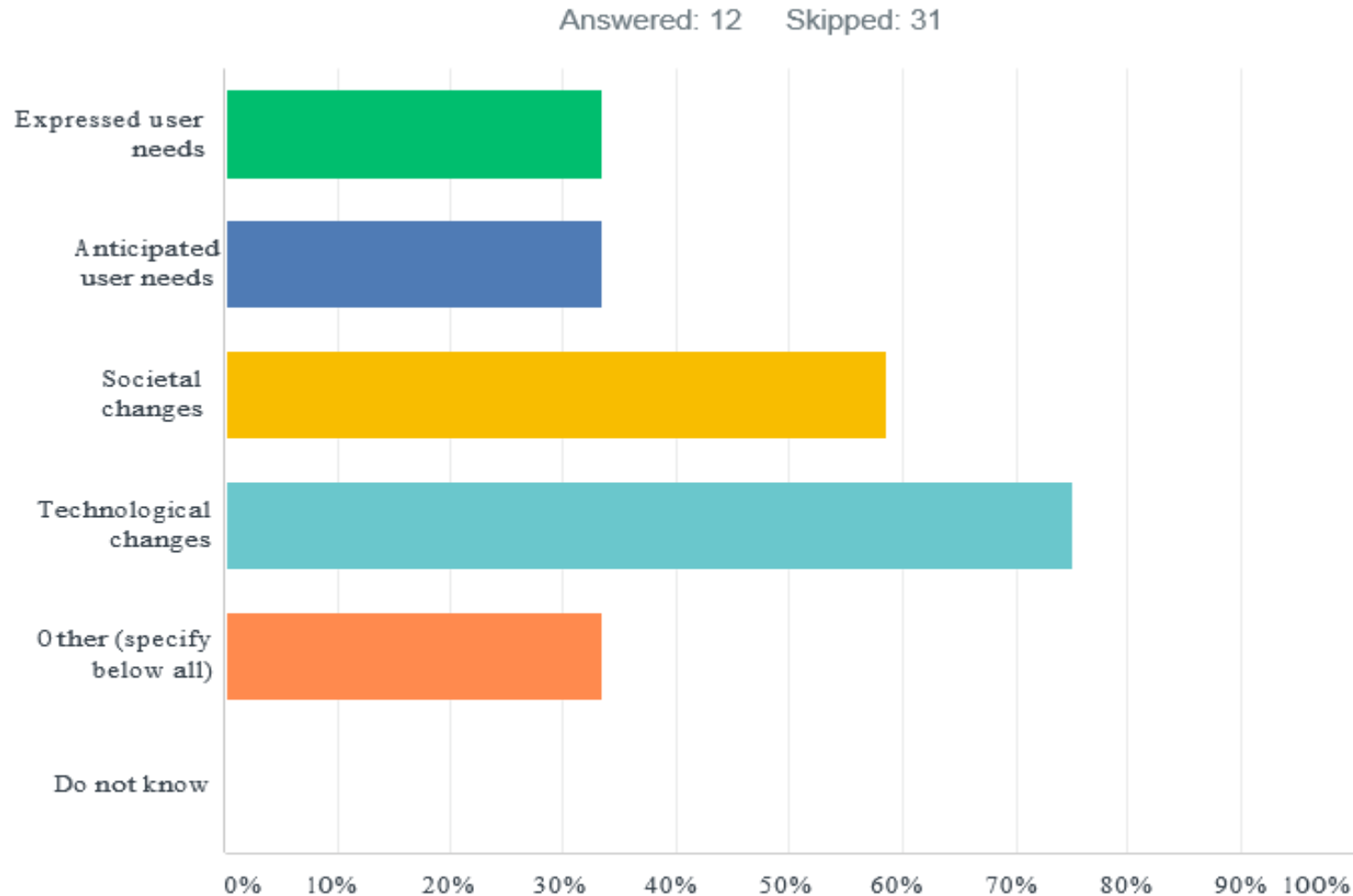
For your next census after the 2020 round, are you foreseeing needs for changes in key concepts?
