Progress monitoring in enlargement countries

- Annual monitoring exercise
 - Self-assessment questionnaire
 - Countries report on status of outstanding actions
 - For statistical domains in AGAs: SMIS+
 - Eurostat collects and analyses info
 - Report the summary to the Policy Group on Statistical Cooperation in each October
 - Discuss the process at the PGSC



Progress monitoring in enlargement countries

- Latest monitoring round in summer 2012
- Main figure: 55 out of 168 actions have been implemented = 33%
- Current monitoring exercise is on-going

Progress monitoring in ENP countries

- ENP countries
 - Annual monitoring set up in 2013
 - First set of questionnaires sent out in June
 - Countries report on status of outstanding actions
 - Eurostat in cooperation with UNECE collects and analyses info
 - Report the summary to the High-Level Seminar in Vilnius in September 2013
 - Discuss the process at the seminar



Progress monitoring questionnaire

- Same format for all countries
- Pre-filled with previous years' data where available
- Recommendations grouped under CoP principles and/or statistical domains
- For each recommendation: improvement actions proposed by NSI
- Status of completion: seven categories + comments, explanations, adjusted deadlines if necessary



Use of the results

- To assess the level of compliance of the country (together with SMIS+)
- Identify areas of assistance
- Input for strategies for statistical cooperation
 - For enlargement countries
 - For ENP countries
- NSIs use it to
 - Record their progress
 - Base future development strategies on
