- Enquiry/ questionnaire (23 RF) is dispatched
- Communication with countries (assistance)
- Country replies are expected by <u>end-July</u>
- Data checking, processing, validation
- Setting up the database
- Possibility of EU funding (application process)
- Arrangements for analysis and writing Report (ToS, MCPFE Advisory Group May 2006)







MCPFE Advisory Group

- General concept of the report and reporting format (14-15 July 2005, Warsaw)
- Scope and coverage of data to be collected
- Terms and definitions applied
- Engagement of experts for data analysis and processing
- Reporting to the MCPFE governing bodies on the implementation
- Close cooperation with ToS (Hamburg, May 2006)




