Why this special topic?

- Outcome from 2005 policy forum on "Forest certification—Do governments have a role?"
 - Lack of info on production, consumption and trade
 - Needed by policy makers, market analysts and market actors
- WPFES asked "to consider how to improve the quality of data on CFPs"

- UNECE/FAO working definition: "CFPs bear labels demonstrating, in a manner verifiable by independent bodies, that they come from forests that meet standards for sustainable forest management"

- Consider secretariat resources
 - Establishment
 - Maintenance







Strategies for UNECE/FAO to expand CFP stats and info-- Questions

- Discuss possible strategies to expand collection, validation, analysis and distribution
- Modalities for new work
 - Informal group to explore topic, then make recommendations to WPFES in 2007
 - In-kind contribution of resources from countries and organizations







Chairman's Summary Questions

- Why do we need improved forest certification info?
 For what specific needs at the national and international level?
- Are CFPs an important subject to compiling stats?
- In your country, what stats and info are available?
- What are the current and potential sources of CFP stats and info?
- Are data gathered on a regular basis? Consider quality, comprehensibility and timeliness.
- Priorities: What are the most important parameters?
 Set priorities, delete/add parameters.







Chairman's summary of possible strategies

- Role and tasks of UNECE/FAO Timber Section?
 Remember comparative advantage vs. resources!
- Roles and tasks of other organisations (Certification Network, certification systems, national statistical correspondents, etc.)
- New data collection system via a loaned expert or team of specialists
