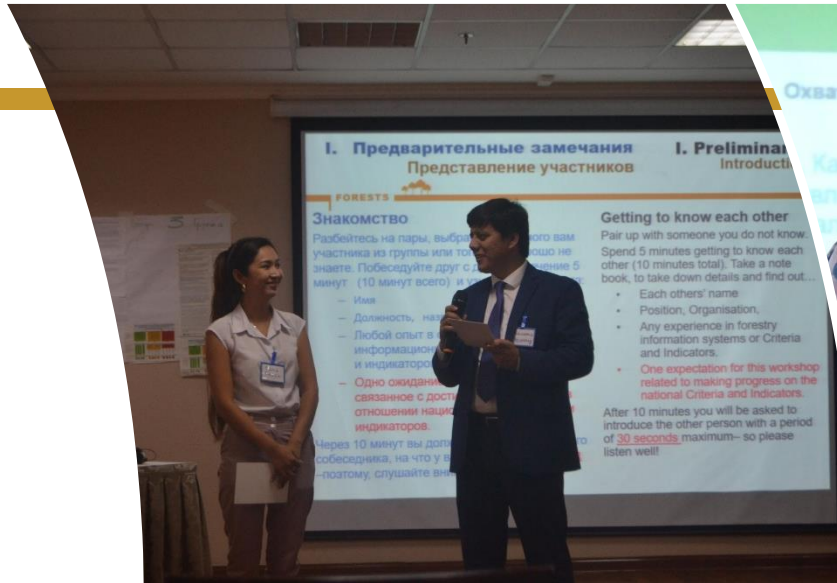

- Developed tailored methodologies for data collection for the selected indicators of the national set of Criteria and Indicator



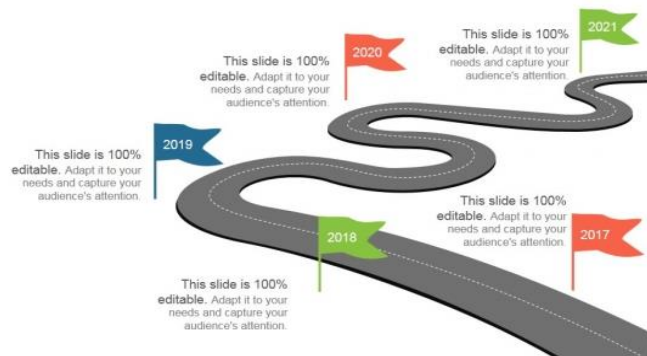
Next steps

FORESTS



Future Plan

- To develop draft of resolution of government for the implementation of developed C&I (December 2020);
- Meeting with relevant ministries and agencies to receive their feedback about the developed draft Resolution of government. (January 2021);
- To receive conclusion of related ministries and agencies about draft of the Resolution (February 2021);
- To receive public suggestions and objections by posting on the government portal
- Adoption of the resolution “on the Implementation of the developed criteria and indicators for sustainable forest management in practice” (March 2021).



Plans for strengthening forest monitoring

- To carry out an inventory of forests;
- To establish Data Center;
- To develop capacity building of specialists;
- To improve methodologies to collect data information for developed C&I.

- To conduct final National Workshop to receive comments and recommendations from concerned ministries and agencies to the drafted resolution of government for the implementation of developed C&I;
- To update methodologies for the collection of data information to developed C&I;
- To develop capacity building of related specialists.

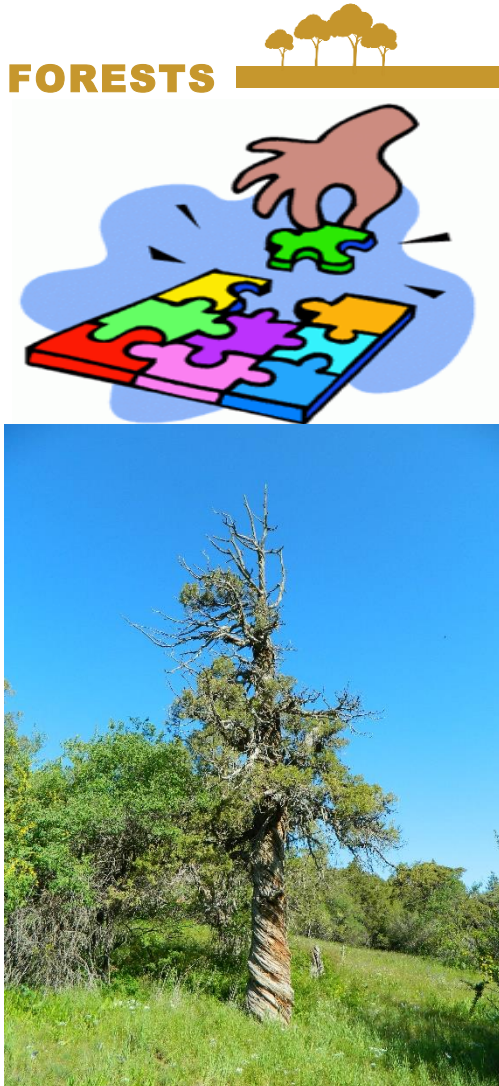
