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## **STATISTICAL APPENDIX**

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For the user's convenience, as well as to lighten the text, the *Economic Survey of Europe* includes a set of appendix tables showing time series for main economic indicators over a longer period. The data are presented in two sections: *Appendix A* provides macroeconomic indicators for the market economies in western Europe and the 10 new EU member states, which joined the European Union at the beginning of May 2004, as well as North America and Japan. *Appendix B* provides comparative macroeconomic indicators for the south-east European countries and the Commonwealth of Independent States, as well as trade and payments data for the ECE emerging market economies. For all countries, national accounts data for more recent years may be subject to revision as more comprehensive benchmark figures become available.

Data were compiled from international and national statistical sources. Greece, which became a member of the euro area at the beginning of 2001, has been included in the euro area aggregates for all years shown in the appendix tables in order to ensure continuity of time series.

It should be noted that for some series the figures shown for recent years in the appendix may differ slightly from those in the text tables due to revisions which were reported after the text had been finalized. In general, the statistical appendix figures are based on data available in June 2005.
