PROTOCOL ON WATER AND HEALTH IN BELARUS

- 2009 Belarus ratified Protocol;
- 2010 established Council for the Protocol on Water and Health Implementation (MoH & MoEnv)

 Interministerial and interstakeholders coordination mechanism
- 2010-2011: complex analysis of water sector conducted (water, sanitation, hygiene, recreational, water bodies protection, alternative water sources)
 => prioritizing of needs and actions through all water cycle
- 2013 List of 15 targets and measures to achieve them was set in 10 target areas;
- First steps to harmonize State Programs and National Action Plans in water sector, inform decisions
- VERY VISIBLE RESULTS

SINCE 2015 – NEW IMPLICATION OF THE PROTOCOL - SYNERGY AND SUPPORT SDGs IMPLEMENTATION

applying the Protocol as a tool to achieve the SDGs on water, sanitation and health

Challenges for BLR

updating target indicators and measures to achieve them – in synergy with SDGs

understanding broadly of equitable access to water and sanitation with regard of all aspects of equitable access (different groups of population, institutional groups, financial aspects) and place into policy

developing the new methodology(es) to monitor the targets achievement, implementation and effectiveness of these measures





improvement





PROTOCOL - VISIBLE PROGRESS

significant **improvement** of water quality, DWQS (zero level WRD outbreaks), high level access to improved water and sanitation service,

2018-2019: baseline analysis conducted of the situation in water sector – gaps identification and prioritization of needs with respect to SDGs

self assessment of equitable access to water and sanitation – UNECE score-card methodology at republican and regional levels (with support of UNECE)

Development of **Programs of achievement of SDG 3.9.2 and 6.b.1** (integrate **indirect indicators** of equitable access, e.g. different indicators of equitable access – methodology to measure)

professional capacity building based on international experience learning – RBS, SSWSS





- **Legislation update** RA implementation into the Law, update of Hygienic Standards, legionella, etc
- New Complex of Measures developed to achieve
 Protocol goals has been developed till 2030
 in synergy with SDGs
