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**Re: Paragraph 99 of the Findings and Recommendations of the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee with regard to communication (Ref. ACCC/C/2005/12)**

Dear Madam,

Following dissemination of the final version of the findings and recommendations with regard to the above communication on 3 August 2007 (ECE/MP.PP/C.1/2007/4/Add.1), the attention of the Compliance Committee under the Aarhus Convention has been drawn to the fact that the timeframe for the preparation of the action plan set out in paragraph 99 of the document was too short considering the time of release of the document and the possible absence of relevant experts and officials from their offices in the month of August.

The Committee noted that the original intention of the text in paragraph 99 was to provide a three-month period for the preparation of the action plan, taking into account that such a plan would in effect need to set out a constructive roadmap for the implementation of the recommendations and that its preparation would require consultations with various institutions and agencies and would need to allow for public involvement. It therefore decided, through its electronic decision-making procedure, to extend the timeframe set out in paragraph 99 of the findings and recommendations to 3 November 2007 and requested the secretariat to communicate this decision to the parties concerned as well as to the World Bank, the EBRD and the EIB.
