Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by Germany with provisions of the Convention in connection with German legislation on access to justice in environmental matters (Ref. ACCC/C/2008/31)

As noted in our letter dated 24 December 2008 concerning the above communication, the Committee, at its twenty-second meeting, preliminarily discussed whether and what issues might require further clarification from the parties concerned in order to facilitate further consideration of the communication.

Having concluded this discussion by electronic means, the Committee noted that although the communication alleges several failures in implementation of article 9, it does not refer to any examples of the new legislation being applied in practice. It therefore has requested the secretariat to invite you to submit further details related to some of the matters raised in the communication by addressing the following questions:

- 1. Have there been any cases where the new legislation has been invoked and applied that support the interpretation alleged by the communication?
- 2. If there have been no such cases as yet, why have you chosen to submit the communication to the Compliance Committee before the relevant changes in the law have been tested by the German judiciary?
- 3. Is there any jurisprudence in German courts where the Aarhus Convention has been considered? If so, in which way and what was the outcome?

A number of additional questions have been raised in a letter to the Party concerned, a copy of which is attached for your information. Should you wish to address any of those questions, you are welcome to do so.

We look forward to hearing from you.
