Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by the European Community with provisions of the Convention in connection with access by members of the public to review procedures (Ref. ACCC/C/2008/32)

At its twenty-sixth meeting, the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee continued the deliberations on its findings with regard to the above referenced communication. It noted communication at its twenty-fifth meeting (22-25 September 2009), the Lisbon Treaty had entered into force on 1 December 2009.
