Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by Germany with provisions of the Convention in connection with German legislation on access to justice in environmental matters (Ref. ACCC/C/2008/31)

At its thirty-third meeting (27-28 June 2011), the Committee considered the progress on the above-referenced communication and decided that it would be important for its consideration to await the decision of the German Court (Higher Administrative Court for the Nordrhein-Westfalen Land in Germany) after the preliminary ruling of the Court of Justice of the EU (Case C-115/09).
