- <u>September 2012</u>: Request of EPZ, the owner of the Borssele nuclear power plant, to the Dutch Minister of Economic Affairs for life time extension;
- 24 October 2012: A draft authorisation for life time extension is published;
- <u>25 October 2012</u>: Start of a six week long public participation procedure;
- <u>4 December 2012</u>: Greenpeace sends by letter an opinion to the Dutch Minister of Economic Affairs challenging the intended life time extension and the draft authorisation;
- <u>18 March 2013</u>: Authorisation of the life time extension approved by decision of the Dutch Minister of Economic Affairs;
- <u>20 March 2013</u>: Publication of the granted authorisation; a six weeks period for lodging appeal against the decision starts;
- <u>2 May 2013</u>: Appeal on behalf of Greenpeace at the Raad van State, the Dutch highest Administrative Court;
- <u>31 May 2013</u>: Greenpeace sends additional grounds of appeal of to the Raad van State;
- <u>14 February 2014</u>: Final judgement (case number 201303313/1/A4) of the Raad van State. There is no appeal possible against this verdict.
