

Annex I

- September 2012: Request of EPZ, the owner of the Borssele nuclear power plant, to the Dutch Minister of Economic Affairs for life time extension;
- 24 October 2012: A draft authorisation for life time extension is published;
- 25 October 2012: Start of a six week long public participation procedure;
- 4 December 2012: Greenpeace sends by letter an opinion to the Dutch Minister of Economic Affairs challenging the intended life time extension and the draft authorisation;
- 18 March 2013: Authorisation of the life time extension approved by decision of the Dutch Minister of Economic Affairs;
- 20 March 2013: Publication of the granted authorisation; a six weeks period for lodging appeal against the decision starts;
- 2 May 2013: Appeal on behalf of Greenpeace at the Raad van State, the Dutch highest Administrative Court;
- 31 May 2013: Greenpeace sends additional grounds of appeal of to the Raad van State;
- 14 February 2014: Final judgement (case number 201303313/1/A4) of the Raad van State. There is no appeal possible against this verdict.
