Dear Fiona,

The short answer to the Chair's question is that the Yuzivska oil field is located in a zone that remains under Ukrainian control.

A bit longer explanation is here. At least half of the Yuzivska oil field is located in Kharkivska oblast, which has not been occupied in the current conflict. The part of the field that is situated in the Donetsk oblast has partially been occupied and liberated during the last months. Yet as of today the whole field is under Ukrainian control.

Please see two maps. The first one (in ENG) shows the Yuzivska field, ignore the red mark. It points at Slovyansk which is Ukrainian now. The second one (unfortunatly only in UKR) - the line of fire as of March 25th, 2015, which goes through Stakhanov-Horlivka-Avdiivka.

Hope, this answers the question.
