as reported in our previous communication of 30 September 2016, we assert that the problem at issue, relating to the costs to access to justice in environmental matters, is of primary and exclusive competence of the Ministry of Justice, as it involves amendments to the legislation in force within the competence of the Ministry of Justice.

Therefore, the request for information submitted by the Compliance Committee on 30 January 2018 has been transmitted to the competent Ministry of Justice (8.2.2018) in order to acquire precise elements to reply punctually.

As is to be expected that we cannot give reply by the deadline set in your communication, i.e. 9 March 2018, the Committee is asked to grant a suitable extension of the terms indicated.
