As you will recall, the Compliance Committee had scheduled the hearing to discuss the substance of communication ACCC/C/2015/130 (Italy) at its sixty-sixth meeting (9-13 March 2020), yet had to defer this hearing in light of the extraordinary COVID-19 situation.

Given the serious situation of the COVID-19 pandemic remains ongoing, the Committee proposes, on an exceptional basis, to hold the hearing to discuss the substance of this communication via video conference at its upcoming sixty-seventh meeting (Geneva, 6-10 July 2020). It would propose the hearing take place, via video conference, on Tuesday, 7 July 2020.
