### Statement regarding developments since the MOP (follow-up on decision VI/8)

To whom it may concern,

I believe that the British authorities still do not see the necessity to involve the German public properly into the decision-making on Hinkly Point C (finding of the Committee 89a). Moreover, the ongoing construction works at Hinkly Point C while a belated transboundary participation process was carried out in 2017, is yet another proof that it is not desired by the British government to give the German public a serious and effective chance to participate in the decision-making process regarding Hinkley Point C.
