


Objective(s) and brief summary of the project:</b><br/> The project's objective is to strengthen capacity of CIS countries to conduct population censuses and produce statistics on international migration.<br/> The project will involve CIS-Stat, Rosstat and the national offices of other CIS countries closely in the preparation of the Conference of European Statisticians recommendations for the 2020 census round, to ensure that harmonised solutions are found to the specific situations and data needs of the CIS countries. The project will also improve the availability of data on international migration as well as its reliability and comparability in CIS countries.<br/> The project will include the following activities: (a) a high-level meeting for policymakers and data producers of CIS countries; (b) four capacity-building expert meetings to improve knowledge in census methodology and in using various data sources for migration statistics; and (c) the production of a guide on the use of administrative data and household surveys to measure international migration in the CIS region.</p> |               |               |                    |         |  |
