3. Objective and brief summary of the project:

The objective of the project is to increase the awareness of policy and decision makers on how to integrate modern wood energy heating systems with energy efficiency measures effectively in countries in economic transition, considering socioeconomic situations. The project aims at achieving its objective through the following activities:

- Organization of an exhibition on heating equipment and means of insulation;
- Organization of a two and a half-day experts workshop;
- Production of a short film and factsheets:
- Development of best practice guidelines for policy- and decision-makers.

4. Expected results of the project:

- 1. Increased awareness of the consequences of poor use of fuel wood in target countries for the environment, human health and forests.
- 2. Improved communication and cooperation between different sectors involved.

5. Target group and beneficiaries of the project in the ECE region:

The project targets policy and decision makers, research institutions and specialized agencies, governmental and non-governmental organizations as well as users, practitioners and the general public from beneficiary countries.

Beneficiary countries will be ECE member countries with economies in transition.

6. Justification of project and its relationship to the programme of work:

The project is multi-sectoral. Significant improvements for the consumers' health and the environment can only be achieved through:
i) fuel wood quality; ii) energy efficiency; iii) thermal insulation; and iv) consumer behaviour. Given that the project seeks to maximize synergies between energy, forestry and housing, it will be implemented in close cooperation with the relevant subprogrammes of the ECE (Forestry and Timber, Sustainable Housing and the Sustainable Energy Division)

The project is directly linked to the expected accomplishment (b) "Increased capacity of countries of Eastern Europe, the Caucasus, Central Asia and South-East Europe to achieve sustainable forest management at the national level" of Subprogramme 7 in the ECE Strategic Framework for 2014-2015.
