1. Project title and project number Strengthening capacity of the UNECE member States to collect, disseminate and evaluate data on sustainable forest management

3. Objective and brief summary of the project The objective of the project is to strengthen capacity of the UNECE member States to collect, disseminate and evaluate data on sustainable forest management. The UNECE/FAO Forestry and Timber Section has been actively engaged in monitoring all aspects of forests, forest resources, their functions and services in the region, and making available the information on the state of forests in the UNECE region. The Section has been involved in collecting data, improving its quality, notably by ensuring its international comparability, storing, disseminating and analyzing the data to strengthen the capacity of countries in these areas. However, only a fraction of this information is used and disseminated. Therefore, it is essential to further process, organize and present the entire set of collected data in a user-friendly format. Furthermore, the workshop "Threats to Sustainability of the Forest Sector Workforce" organized in Geneva on 17 March 2015 concluded that more detailed information on the forest sector workforce is required. The project will also assess the results of the pilot implementation of the System for Evaluation of the Management of Forests (SEMAFOR).
