

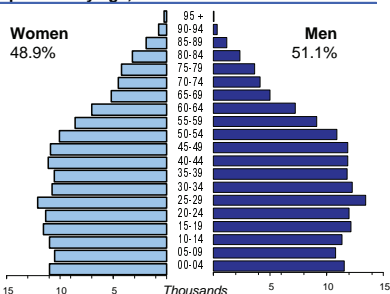

Population by age, 2008



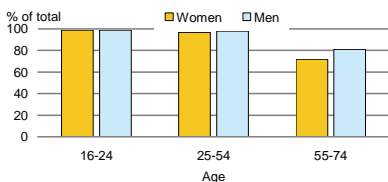

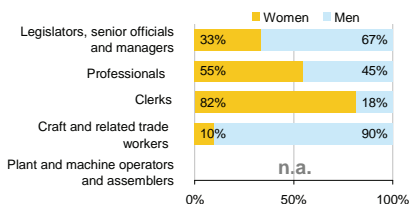

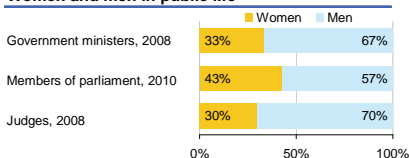

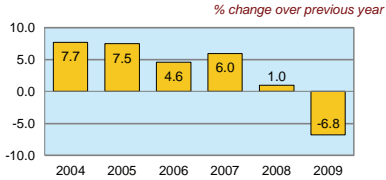

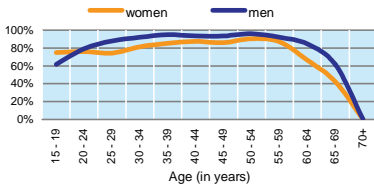

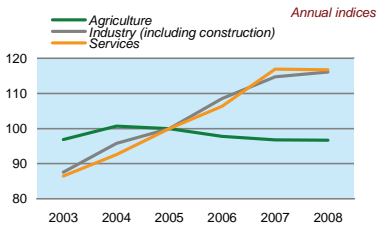
Real GDP growth rate

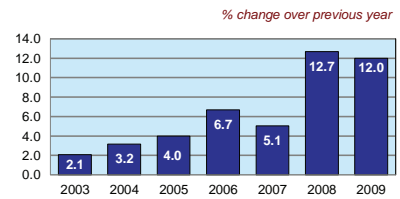

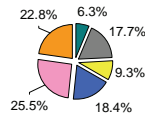

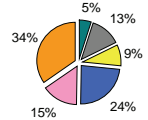
Consumer price index
