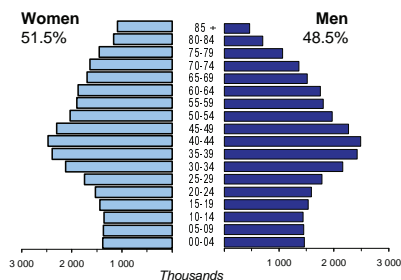

Population by age, 2009



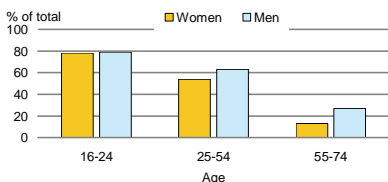

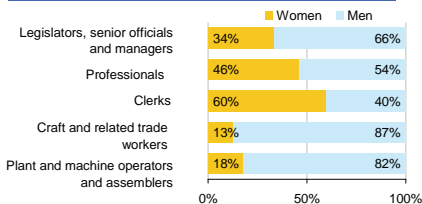

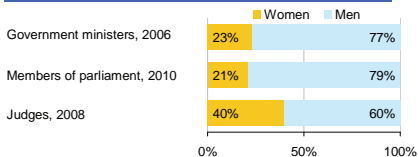

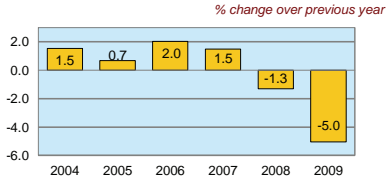

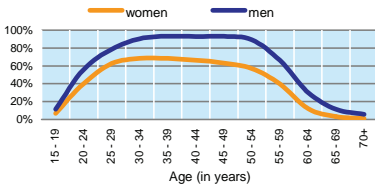

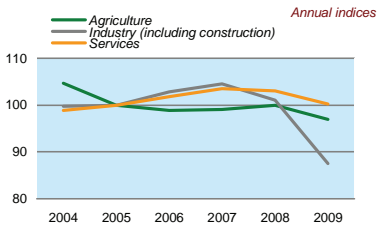
Real GDP growth rate

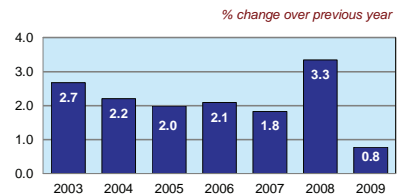

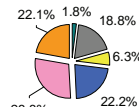

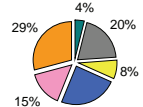
Consumer price index
