

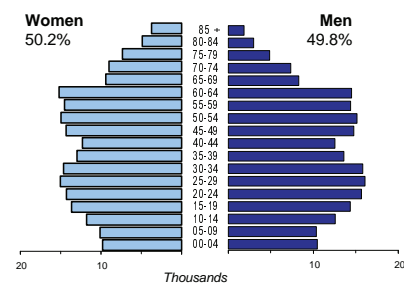

Population by age, 2009



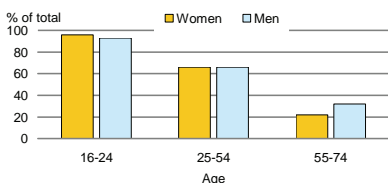

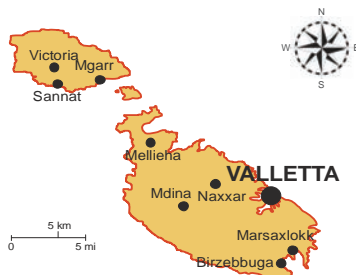

Computer use by age and sex, 2009

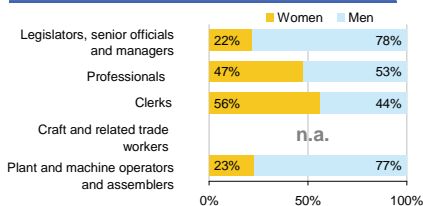

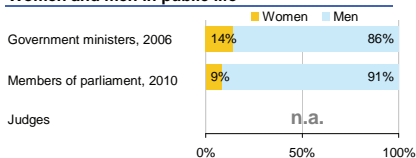

Women and men in selected occupation groups, 2009



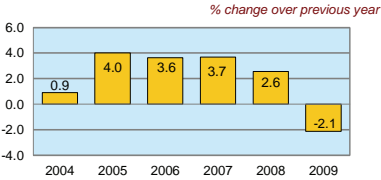

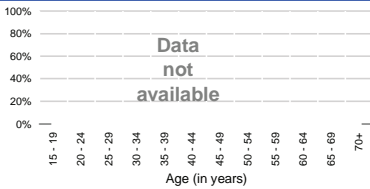

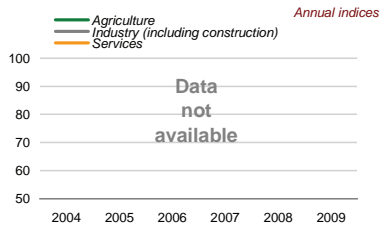
Real GDP growth rate

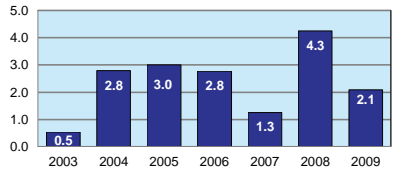

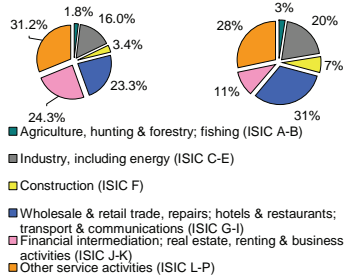

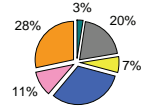
