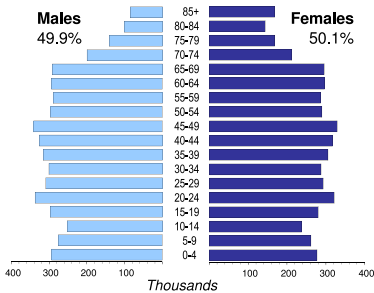

Population by age, 2012



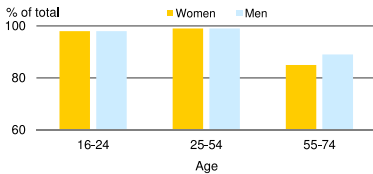

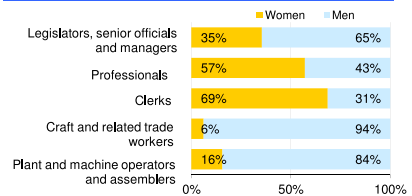

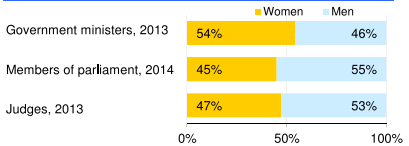

Women and men in selected occupation groups, 2013



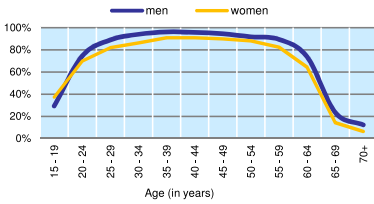

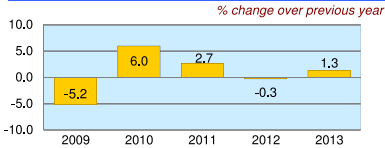

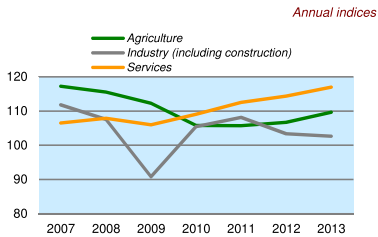

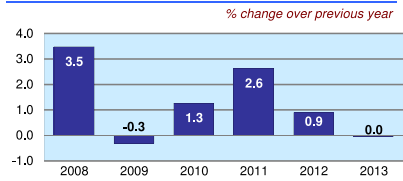

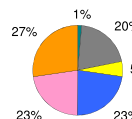

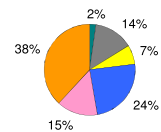
Consumer price index
