ENTRY INTO FORCE OF AMENDMENTS TO ANNEX 6 OF THE CONVENTION<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,

By 1 July 2009, none of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Convention had  
communicated an objection to the Secretary-General. Consequently, in accordance with the provisions  
of article 60 (1) of the Convention, the amendments will enter into force on 1 October 2009 for all  
Contracting Parties.
