ENTRY INTO FORCE OF THE AMENDMENTS REGARDING THE ADDITION OF TWO NEW
 EXPLANATORY NOTES TO ARTICLE 6.2.BIS AND ANNEX 8, ARTICLE 10 (B)
 OF THE TIR CONVENTION¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
 communicates the following:

By 12 May 2006, none of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Convention had
 communicated an objection to the Secretary-General. Consequently, in accordance with the provisions
 of article 60 (1) of the Convention, the amendments regarding the addition of two new Explanatory
 Notes to Article 6.2.bis and Annex 8, Article 10 (b) of the TIR Convention will enter into force on 12
 August 2006 for all Contracting Parties.
