## **Training on relevant international standards for developing a Single Window and paperless trade environment in Greece**

**22 and 21 October 2014**

### **Objective of the workshop**

The training will provide an overview of relevant international standards used in the European Commission, in particular DG TAXUD and DG MOVE for data harmonization and Single Window development. The training will introduce into the technical details of these standards for data harmonization and development of electronic trade documents. It will present a stepwise approach for Greek data harmonization experts develop a data model and electronic trade documents on the basis of paper forms used in Greek administrations.

### **What will a participant get from the training?**

An understanding about the most relevant document standards both on exchange syntax free level (data models) and on exchange syntax, about their directions, their capabilities and limitations.

A clear picture what the current work status of TAXUD is with respect to the implementation of the UCC and to the work of the Single Window Working Group.

The knowledge about data standard and used methods that allow to make decisions about the own path and directions.

Understanding of the practical steps to dematerialize paper forms using international standards.

Note: If time and interest allows all data will be presented as they are in the original formats, i.e. the participants will see a snapshot of the work in progress.
