UNECE RECOMMENDATION FOR PLUMS

Proposals Transmitted by Germany

Note by the secretariat: The delegation of Germany proposes a number of amendments to the recommendation in trial period as a way to deal with the inter-specific hybrids derived from plums and apricots in the standard (New text is underlined).

UNECE RECOMMENDATION FOR PLUMS

1. In I. DEFINITION OF PRODUCE amend the indent concerning hybrids to read:

“- inter-specific hybrids derived from plums (*Prunus domestica*) and apricots (*Prunus armeniaca*) – also known as Plumcot® (*Prunus domestica* X *Prunus armeniaca*) and Pluot® (*Prunus armeniaca* X *Prunus domestica* X *Prunus domestica*) – showing plum characteristics (see list of varieties).“

2. Amend footnote 1 to read as follows:

¹ See list annexed to this standard. Moreover, varieties of inter-specific hybrids are regarded as large fruited.

3. In the annex delete the non-exhaustive list of large-fruited varieties of hybrids.
