AMENDMENTS TO THE UNECE STANDARD FOR PRUNES

Note by the Secretariat: The Specialized Section agreed the amendments contained in this document at its 50th session and recommends to the Working Party to revise the UNECE Standard for Prunes accordingly.

- 1. Amend III D. as follows (new text is underlined):
- D. "Pressure Pitted Prunes" "Type E", "Class II"

Sizing of pressure pitted prunes is not obligatory <u>unless they are sold in small packages intended for the consumer.</u>

2. In the Annex concerning methods of determining the moisture content of prunes amend the first paragraph as follows (new text is underlined):

Preparation of the sample

On the basis of a representative sample of the consignment, approximately 450 g of the prunes are taken. The prunes, without pits, are crushed in a food grinder with a mesh gauge not greater than 4.76 mm (3/16 of an inch).

This operation is performed as quickly as possible to avoid loss of moisture.
