Item 1. Adoption of the Agenda

The Specialized Section recommended that the Working Party adopt the revised text of the Standard Layout for a trial period of one year.

The Specialized Section submitted the revised texts on apricots, cucumbers, and peaches and nectarines for adoption as recommendations for trial use until the end of 2008.

(d) Initiation of work on new UNECE standards

The Specialized Section asked the Working Party to approve the initiation of work on two new UNECE standards for chanterelles and fresh chilli peppers, proposed by the delegations of France and Mexico, respectively.

Item 5. Specialized Section on Standardization of Dry and Dried Produce

<u>Documentation:</u> Report of the fifty-fourth session (ECE/TRADE/C/WP.7/GE.2/2007/14)

(a) Revised Standard Layout for UNECE standards on dry and dried produce

The Specialized Section recommended that the Working Party adopt the revised text of the Standard Layout for a trial period of one year.

(b) Texts for adoption as new/revised UNECE standards

The Specialized Section submitted the amended texts on inshell almonds, dried tomatoes and inshell hazelnuts for adoption as new/revised UNECE standards.

(c) Texts for adoption/extension as UNECE recommendations

The Specialized Section submitted the revised texts on pistachio kernels and peeled pistachio kernels, dried peaches and inshell walnuts for adoption as recommendations for trial use until the end of 2008. It also asked to extend the trial period for one more year for the recommendations for hazelnut kernels and blanched almond kernels.

(d) Initiation of work on new UNECE standards

The Specialized Section asked the Working Party to approve the initiation of work on a new UNECE standard for dry chilli peppers, proposed by the delegation of Mexico.

(e) Suspension of work

The Specialized Section recommended that work on four standards - inshell pecans, pecan kernels, inshell peanuts and peanut kernels - be suspended.

Item 6. Specialized Section on Standardization of Meat

<u>Documentation:</u> Report of the sixteenth session (ECE/TRADE/C/WP.7/GE.11/2007/6)

(a) Texts for adoption as new/revised UNECE standards

The Specialized Section submitted the amended texts on bovine, caprine and turkey meat for adoption as new/revised UNECE standards.

(b) Initiation of work on new UNECE standards

The Specialized Section asked the Working Party to approve the initiation of work on a new UNECE standard for yeal meat and on the revision of standards for eggs and egg products.

Item 7. Interpretation of UNECE Standards

(a) Colour gauge for walnut kernels

The delegation of the United States of America will present a revised colour gauge for walnut kernels for approval by the Working Party.

(b) Brochures on sweet peppers and on inshell walnuts and walnut kernels

At its May 2006 session, the Specialized Section on Standardization of Fresh Fruit and Vegetables agreed that the UNECE secretariat should start work on brochures on sweet peppers and on inshell walnuts and walnut kernels. The Working Party will be asked to approve these initiatives.

Item 8. General questions

(a) Questionnaire on the use of UNECE standards

The secretariat will present a draft questionnaire for approval by the Working Party. The questionnaire was drawn up by the secretariat following the decision by the Working Party at its November 2006 session. It reflects comments made by the specialized sections.

(b) UNECE website

The secretariat will present a reorganized UNECE website on standards and Working Party activities.

(c) Lists of authorities

The OECD secretariat will provide information on this item.

Item 9. Capacity-building activities

The secretariat and delegations will exchange information on capacity-building, training, promotional and other activities that have taken place since the November 2006 session of the Working Party or are planned for the near future.

Participants may wish to discuss any other issues of interest for the work of the Working Party.

The Working Party will decide on its future work.

Item 12. Election of officers
