UNECE TELECOM INITIATIVE - STATUS

- There has been limited interest from Member Countries towards applying the International Model to the ICT sector
- The proposed Common Regulatory Objectives under the Telecom Initiative provide practical examples of good regulatory practice
- There are proposals in the WTO addressing Non Tariff Barriers for the products under the Telecom Initiative



NTB PROPOSALS FOR ICT IN WTO

- > EU: NAMA contribution <u>TN/MA/W/119</u> (dated 9 September 2009) "Understanding on the Interpretation of the Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade as Applied to Trade in Electronics",
 - The Telecom Initiative corresponds to conformity assessment "option a" for Electromagnetic Compatibility and Safety
- > US: NAMA contribution <u>TN/MA/W/105/Rev.2</u> (dated 15 September 2009) "Negotiating Text on Non-Tariff Barriers Pertaining to the Electrical Safety and Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC) of Electronic Goods"

SYNERGIES BETWEEN WTO NTBS AND UNECE INTERNATIONAL MODEL



> WTO NAMA Propsals

- NAMA: Covering
 "electronics" (EC),
 "electronic goods" (US)
- Electromagnetic compatibility and safety
- International standards
- Conformity assessment
- Transparency
- Establishing permanent working party/committee

- > UNECE Telecom Initiative
 - Initially 7 ICT products (covered by NAMA/ITA proposals)
 - Electromagnetic compatibility, safety and radio
 - International standards
 - Conformity assessment
 - Transparency
