PROPOSAL

Page 2, inserted new paragraph 2.7.10.1., correct to read:

"2.7.10.1. "<u>Principal dipped beam</u>" **means** the dipped beam produced without the contribution of infrared (IR) emitter and/or **additional light sources for bend lighting.**"

Page 2, paragraph 6.2.8., correct to read:

"6.2.8. <u>Tell-tale</u>

- 6.2.8.1. Tell-tale optional.
- 6.2.8.2. An operational tell-tale is mandatory:
 - in the case where the whole beam or the kink of the elbow of the cut-off is moved to produce bend lighting;
 - if one or more LED modules are used to produce the principal dipped-beam.

It shall be a flashing warning light which comes on:

- in the event of a malfunction of the displacement of the kink of the elbow of the cut-off, or
- in case of a failure of any one of the LED module(s) producing the principal dipped-beam."

Page 3, paragraph 6.2.9., correct to read:

"6.2.9. to dipped-beam headlamps.

Dipped-beam headlamps with a light source or LED module(s) having a total objective luminous flux which exceeds 2,000 lumen shall only be installed in conjunction"
