A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 6.3.2., amend to read (deletion of the second sentence):

"6.3.2. It is possible to use several or Regulation No. 99."

Insert a new paragraph 6.3.3., to read:

"6.3.3. The illumination produced on the screen by the driving beam shall meet the following requirements:"

<u>Paragraphs 6.3.2.1., 6.3.2.2.</u> and 6.3.2.3. (former), renumber as paragraphs 6.3.3.1., 6.3.3.2. and 6.3.3.3.
